

Dress Code for Concerts

09-10

Prelude and Overture Strings, and Intermezzo Orchestra

Girls: Long black skirts/black pants and white blouses that can be tucked in; black shoes and black tights or nylons. (**No** tennis shoes, sandals, flip flops, white shoes or white tights.)

Boys: Black pants, long sleeved white shirt, black bow tie, black shoes and black socks.

Symphony Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, Flute Choir/Select Flute Choir and Clarinet Choir:

Girls: Black dress or black skirt (mid-calf or longer)/ black dress pants (not tight), and black tops that cover the top of the skirt, black shoes and black tights or nylons.

(No tennis shoes, sandals, flip flops, white shoes or white tights.)

Boys: Black jacket, black pants, long sleeved white shirt, black bow tie, black shoes and black socks.

NYSO Chorale:

Girls will wear long black skirts and will order matching burgundy tops. Boys will wear the concert dress listed above for Symphony Orchestra.

For all ensembles, please note: Concert dress is required for concerts only. Final rehearsals before concerts (formally called “dress rehearsals”) do not require concert dress.
